ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION
OF THE PROHIBITED PRACTICE CHARGE

On July 11, 1979, the Complainant filed prohibited practice charges with this Board against both Eduardo E. Malapit, Mayor of the County of Kauai (hereinafter Respondent) and the United Public Workers (hereinafter UPW). The Respondent received notice of the prohibited practice charge on July 13, 1979. Thereafter, the Respondent filed a Motion for Particularization of the Complaint on July 20, 1979. The Motion, it is noted, was not accompanied by the required affidavit.

The absence of the affidavit notwithstanding, this motion is denied for the reason that the Petition filed herein is not so vague and indefinite that Respondent cannot reasonably be required to frame an answer thereto. Respondent shall file and serve his Answer to the petition herein no later than five working days after the date of this Order.
