On September 13, 2011, the parties submitted a Stipulation to Dismiss with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The parties agreed that the Prohibited Practice Complaint filed on July 18, 2008, as amended, is dismissed without prejudice pursuant to the settlement agreement effective September 12, 2011 between the Hawaii State Teachers Association, the Board of Education, State of Hawaii, Neil Abercrombie, Neil Dietz, and Kathryn Matayoshi, with each party to bear its own fees and costs. There are no remaining claims, parties, or issues.

Based upon a review of the record and the foregoing Stipulation to Dismiss, the Board hereby dismisses the instant Complaint, as amended. This case is closed.




