ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION  
TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On January 13, 2012, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (UHPA), by and through its counsel, filed a Motion to Withdraw Prohibited Practice Complaint (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's counsel states in a declaration dated January 13, 2012, and attached to the motion, *inter alia*, that the parties have reached a settlement of the matters contained in the Complaint; withdrawal of the instant Complaint is a condition of the settlement agreement; the settlement resolves all issues between the parties with each party to bear its own fees and costs; and Respondent's counsel does not oppose the Motion.

Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants UHPA's Motion. The Board appreciates the parties' efforts to resolve this matter.


