ORDER APPROVING STIPULATED WITHDRAWAL
OF PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT, FILED ON JULY 3, 2012

On July 3, 2012, the above-named parties, by and through their respective counsel, stipulated and moved that Complainant withdraw with prejudice, Prohibited Practice Complaint CE-07-800 (PPC), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-8 and 12-42-44, with each party bearing its own fees and costs. The parties noted that they have entered into a Memorandum of Agreement that resolves all issues raised by the PPC.

Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44 provides that a complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order upon motion and with the consent of the Board. Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby approves the Stipulated Withdrawal of the Prohibited Practice Complaint and grants Complainant's withdrawal of its complaint filed on April 2, 2012.


