ORDER GRANTING AMENDMENT OF PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On December 13, 2012, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) conducted a prehearing/settlement conference by conference call in this matter with Complainant, *pro se*, and counsel for Respondent ROBERT F. WESTERMAN, Fire Chief, Fire Department, County of Kauai (Westerman), participating by telephone and counsel for Respondents DALE SHIMOMURA, Business Agent, Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME, Local 152, AFL-CIO and HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (collectively HGEA) appearing before the Board.

The Board noted that it issued Order No. 2867, Granting Respondent Dale Shimomura and Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME, Local 152, AFL-CIO's Motion for Particularization of Complaint, Filed on November 26, 2012 and County of Kauai Respondent's Motion for Particularization of the Complaint, Filed on November 28, 2012. On December 11, 2012, Complainant filed a letter with the Board asking for an extension regarding the motion for particularization because he did not know about the Board's order until he contacted the Board on December 6, 2012 and the Board sent the documents by email. Respondents' respective counsel acknowledged receipt of Complainant's request for extension. Complainant stated that he sent a letter to the Board with specific information regarding the Complaint yesterday. Respondent Westerman objected to an extension of time.

Based on the foregoing and considering Complainant's request for an extension, the Board permitted Complainant to file an Amended Complaint with the Board to include the more specific information by the close of business on **December 20, 2012**. The Board also set **January 4, 2013** as the deadline for Respondents to file their respective answers to the Amended Complaint. Accordingly, the hearing previously scheduled on December 27, 2012 at 1:00 p.m. has been taken off the calendar.


