PROHIBITED PRACTICE CHARGE


On October 15, 2013, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) by and through its attorneys KING, NAKAMURA, and CHUNHOON, filed a MOTION TO DISMISS PROHIBITED PRACTICE CHARGE with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-44.

Respondent CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, Honolulu Emergency Services Department, Emergency Medical Services did not file an opposition to the motion.

HAR § 12-42-44 provides that any complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order thereon, upon motion and consent of the Board. Based on a review of the record and consideration of the instant motion, the Board grants the withdrawal of the instant Complaint, with prejudice. This case is closed and the Status Conference scheduled for November 5, 2013 at 10:00 is therefore taken off of the calendar.




