
On December 30, 2013, Complainant DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, State of Hawaii (Complainant), by and through its attorneys, filed COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT DATED JULY 22, 2013, with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-44.

On January 3, 2014, Respondents UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO and DAYTON NAKANELUA (Respondents), by and through their counsel, filed with the Board RESPONDENTS' STATEMENT OF NO OBJECTION TO COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED ON 12/30/13.


