ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO  
WITHDRAW COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On April 10, 2014, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW, Union) by and through its attorney, Herbert R. Takahashi, Esq., filed a MOTION TO WITHDRAW PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-8(g)(3) and § 12-42-44 in accordance with a settlement agreement entered by the Union, the City and County of Honolulu, and James Kopa Kaawalaule dated April 4, 2014.

There was no opposition to the motion.

HAR § 12-42-44 provides that any complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order thereon, upon motion and consent of the Board. Based on a review of the record and consideration of the instant motion, the Board grants the withdrawal of the instant Complaint, without prejudice. This case is closed.


