

Takahashi Esq., filed a MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-8 (g) (3) and HAR § 12-42-44.

HAR § 12-42-44 provides that any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order thereon, upon motion and consent of the Board. Based on a review of the record and consideration of the instant motion, the Board grants the withdrawal of the instant Complaint, without prejudice. This case is closed.




