WITHDRAW COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE


On May 21, 2014, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) by and through its attorney Herbert R. Takahashi, Esq, filed a MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-8 (g) (3) and § 12-42-44.

There was no opposition to the Motion.

HAR § 12-42-44 provides that any complaint can be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order thereon, upon motion and consent of the Board. Based on a review of the record and consideration of the instant motion, the Board grants the withdrawal of the instant Complaint, without prejudice. This case is closed.




