ORDER GRANTING HSTA'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING  
NOTICED FOR SEPTEMBER 15-16, 2014; NOTICE OF STATUS CONFERENCE

On August 25, 2014, Complainant Hawaii State Teachers Association (HSTA or Complainant), by and through its Counsel, filed with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) HSTA'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING NOTICED FOR SEPTEMBER 15-16, 2014 (Motion) with an affidavit of HSTA's counsel (Affidavit). The Motion requested the hearing scheduled for September 15 and 16 be rescheduled to new dates in late October or early November, 2014. The affidavit of HSTA's counsel included a letter from Respondent's counsel stating that he had no objections to extending the September 15-16, 2014 trial date to a later date.

On August 29, 2014, the Board received a letter from HSTA's Counsel signed by counsel for both parties stating "that the parties agree that the current deadlines on calendar (subpoena submissions, witness and exhibit lists, etc.) can also be taken off calendar and rescheduled according to the new hearing date to be set by the Board."

Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Board hereby GRANTS the Motion. The hearing scheduled for September 15 and 16, 2014 has been taken off the calendar.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) will conduct a status conference with the parties on **October 1, 2014, at 9:00 a.m.** in the Board's hearing room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu Hawaii. The purpose of the status conference is to establish dates for the hearing on the merits and deadlines.
