## ORDER GRANTING UPW'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On November 12, 2014, the United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO, (Complainant or UPW) by and through its attorney Herbert R. Takahashi Esq. filed UPW'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-8 (g) (3) & § 12-42-44.

There was no opposition to the Motion.

HAR § 12-42-44 provides that "Any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order thereon, upon motion and consent of the board. Whenever the board approves withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed." Based on a review of the record and consideration of the instant motion the Board consents and grants the withdrawal of the instant Complaint, without prejudice. This case is closed.
