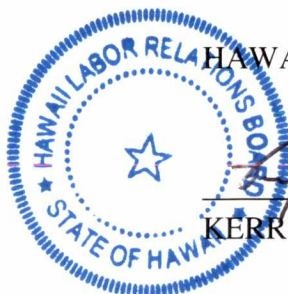

**ORDER DISMISSING PROHIBITED
PRACTICE COMPLAINT DUE TO MOOTNESS**

On July 30, 2015, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued its Notice of Intent to Dismiss Prohibited Practice Complaint Due to Mootness (Notice) in the above-captioned matter, notifying the parties of the Board's intention to dismiss the Prohibited Practice Complaint (Complaint) due to mootness unless the Board received written objection from any party to the proceeding, within ten (10) days of issuance of the July 30, 2015 Notice, setting forth good cause as to why the case should not be dismissed. In the Notice, the Board stated that it found and concluded that Complainant's Complaint in this matter is moot, because Complainant has been made whole by Board Decision No. 480 in Case No. CE-03-824 issued on January 5, 2015, which is now final.

The deadline to file a written objection to dismissal of the Complaint filed in this matter has passed. Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Complainant's Complaint is dismissed with prejudice. This case is now closed.
