## <u>ERRATA TO ORDER GRANTING</u> COMPLAINANT'S WITHDRAWAL OF COMPLAINT, EXHIBIT "A"

On November 4, 2015, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued Order No. 3116 Order Granting Complainant's Withdrawal of Complaint; Exhibit "A" (Order) regarding the Prohibited Practice Complaint (Complaint) in the above-captioned matter. The Board issues this Errata to that Order to correct an error regarding the reference in the Order to the Hawaii Administrative Rule (HAR) governing the withdrawal of a complaint filed under Chapter 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Instead of HAR § 12-42-24, cited in Order No. 3116, the operative rule in this case is HAR §12-42-44, which provides as follows:

Any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final order thereon, upon motion and with the consent of the board. Whenever the board approves the withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed.

The Board considers and interprets the October 29, 2015 notice of withdrawal letter filed by Complainant RICHARD ST. ONGE, pro se, to be a motion to withdraw Complainant's Complaint against Respondent DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, WINDWARD DISTRICT OFFICE, STATE OF HAWAII filed October 14, 2015 in the above matter, and with the authority pursuant to HAR § 12-42-44 hereby reaffirms its holding in Order No. 3116, GRANTING the withdrawal of the Complaint in the matter, and closing this case.
