## ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT FILED SEPTEMBER 8, 2015, FILED ON NOVEMBER 3, 2015

On November 3, 2015, Complainant KELLI KEAWE (Complainant) filed "Complainant, Kelli Keawe Request a Withdraw of My Complaint Filed against [Respondents] HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE ASSOCIATION AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO, SANFORD CHUN, Union Agent and JOAN TAKENO, Union Agent" (Withdrawal Request) at the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) in the above-captioned matter. In the Withdrawal Request, Complainant stated that an "understanding and clarification" had been reached between the parties after an agent of Respondent Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME, Local 152 (HGEA) met with Complainant's Employer and Complainant's immediate supervisor, Corey Reincke, regarding Complainant's "complaint to establish any [sic] violation to Article 21 of my [Collective] Bargaining Agreement", and through Respondent's Attorney, Debra Kagawa, a "mutual agreement" was reached with HGEA's "understanding".

On November 4, 2014, Respondent filed with the Board Respondent's Statement of No Opposition to Complainant's Request to Withdraw Complaint Filed September 8, 2015, Filed on November 3, 2015. Respondent stated that Respondent interposes no objection to Complainant's November 3, 2015 Withdrawal Request.

Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-44 provides that "Any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final order thereon, upon motion and with the consent of the board. Whenever the board approves withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed."

The Board interprets and consider the November 3, 2015 Withdrawal Request by Complainant, pro se, to be a motion to withdraw the Complaint filed September 8, 2015, pursuant to HAR § 12-42-44. As such, and given the lack of any objection to the Withdrawal Request by Respondent, as expressed in Respondent's November 4, 2015 Statement of No Opposition, the Board hereby GRANTS the withdrawal of the Prohibited Practice Complaint in the above captioned matter, with prejudice. This case is closed.
