On January 28, 2016, Respondents DARRYL PERRY, Chief of Police, Kaua'i Police Department, County of Kaua'i, and MICHAEL CONTRADES, Deputy Chief of Police, Kaua'i Police Department, County of Kaua'i, (jointly, Respondents) filed an Agreement for Case Closure (Agreement). The Agreement was signed by (1) the Respondents, (2) the Respondents' counsel, (3) Complainant Shelley L. Rodrigues (Complainant) and (4) Complainant's representative. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement (which terms and conditions are incorporated herein by reference), the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) unanimously:

(A) Accepts the withdrawal of Respondents' Motion for Reconsideration and/or for Relief from Judgment or Order Re: The Denial of Respondents' Motion to Dismiss Dated

October 31, 2013 filed on January 7, 2013 (Motion for Reconsideration), and the Motion for Reconsideration is deemed to be withdrawn.

(B) Accepts Complainant's withdrawal of her remaining claims in this case, including the claims Complainant's "two allegations of retaliation", i.e., "the failure by Perry to address Complainant's February 17, 2013 request to comply with the Step III decision and of the F.T.O. opportunity" as more fully set forth in the Board's Order No. 3133 filed on December 21, 2015 in this case.

(C) Since there are no claims outstanding and the parties agreed that this case be closed, pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules Section 12-41-44, orders that the case entitled In the Matter of Shelley L. Rodrigues, Complainant, and Darryl Perry, Chief of Police, Kaua'i Police Department, County of Kaua'i; and Michael Contrades, Deputy Chief of Police, Kaua'i Police Department, County of Kaua'i, Respondents, Case No. CE-12-822, be and hereby is closed.
