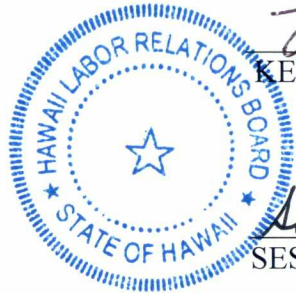
ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR CONTINUED
