On October 24, 2016, HGEA/AFSCME (Complainant) filed HGEA'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED ON APRIL 17, 2015 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) §§ 12-42-8 (g) (3) (C) and 12-42-44. Complainant stated, *inter alia*, that this dispute has remained suspended for the purpose of resolution since May 14, 2015. Further, on October 10, 2016, a final signature to the Stipulation and Settlement Agreement was completed and executed between the Parties hereto.

On October 24, 2016, RESPONDENTS STATEMENT OF NO OBJECTION TO HGEA/AFSCME MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED ON APRIL 17, 2015, was received by the Board.

HAR § 12-42-44 provides that, “Any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order thereon, upon motion and consent of the Board. Whenever the board approves withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed.” Based on a review of the record and consideration of the instant motion the Board grants the withdrawal of the instant Complaint. This case is closed.
