ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT

On March 1, 2017, Joshua Hollaway (Complainant) filed a Prohibited Practice Complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board ("Board").

On March 7, 2017, the Board held a Prehearing Conference. Joshua Hollaway, Complainant, appeared *pro se.* The Hawaii Teachers Association (Respondent/HSTA) was represented by counsel, Keani Alapa, Esq., and the Department of Education (Respondent/DOE) was represented by counsel, Miriam P. Loui, Deputy Attorney General.

On March 17, 2017, the Board issued NOTICE OF DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS, DEADLINES, AND HEARING ON THE MERTS to all parties in the above referenced cases.

On March 21, 2017, the Complainant sent a communication to the Board and all the Respondents requesting to withdraw his complaints in the above referenced cases. Mr. Hollaway stated, *inter alia*, "Please consider this to be my official termination of my complaint against both parties."

ORDER

The Complainant having set forth in writing his request to the Board to withdraw his complaint against all parties in Case Nos. 17-CU-05-347 and 17-CE-05-889, the Board finds that the withdrawal of the complaint would not prejudice either Respondent. Pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, "[a]ny complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior

to the issuance of a final order thereon, upon motion and with the consent of the [Board]. Whenever the [B]oard approves withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed."

Therefore, the Board grants the Complainant's request to withdraw the complaint in the above referenced cases as set forth in Order No. 3240

The cases are hereby dismissed and closed.
