WHEREAS, counsel for respondent has other deadlines in the coming week and has no objections to a continuance on the deadline to file objections; and.

WHEREAS, counsel for complainant has several briefs due in the next month.


NOW therefore, it is hereby stipulated and agreed to between the parties that

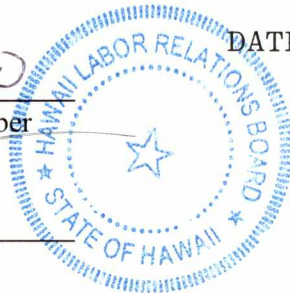
