On April 11, 2017, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) held a STATUS CONFERENCE which was held with respect to Cases Nos. CE-01-605a and CE-605b. UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (Complainant) was represented by counsel Rebecca Covert, Esq. MARIE LADERTA, Director, Department of Human Resources Development, State of Hawaii; and VALERIE PACHECO, Personnel Program Administrator, Department of Human Resources Development, State of Hawaii (Respondents) were represented by Jeffery Keating, Deputy Attorney General.

Upon review of the record and transcript, and arguments presented by the respective counsel during the status conference, the Board issues the deadlines for the submission of a Stipulation of Undisputed Facts, and submission of Proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order and Decision.

ORDER

1. The Parties shall submit a Notice to the Board offering a Stipulation of Undisputed Facts by **4:30 p.m., on Monday June 26, 2017**. If the Parties are unable to reach an agreement over such a Stipulation, they shall so notify the Board no later than the time and date set forth above.

2. The Parties shall each submit to the Board a statement of Proposed Finding of Facts, Conclusions of Law, and a Proposed Order and Decision in the matter of the above referenced cases, by **4:30 p.m. on Monday, September 1, 2017.**
