ORDER ACCEPTING COMPLAINANT'S FILING OF A SECOND AMENDED PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT DATED OCTOBER 14, 2017 AS A SECOND MOTION TO AMEND THE PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On October 23, 2017, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) held a Prehearing Conference in consolidated cases 17-CE-10-900 and 17-CU-10-356. During the Prehearing Conference, the Board *ruled* that it would accept the Complainant Craig Pinkney's filing of a 2nd Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint (PPC) on October 14, 2017 as a motion to amend the prohibited practice complaint affecting the consolidated cases 17-CE-10-900 and 17-CU-10-356. A deadline of Monday, October 30, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. was set for Respondents to file a response. The Board further ruled that it would hold a hearing on the Respondent State of Hawai'i, Department of Public Safety's Motion to Dismiss Prohibited Practice Complaint filed on October 2, 2017. The Board stated that both motions would be taken up at the commencement of the Hearing on Merits scheduled for November 8, 2017. The Board went on to state that after both motions were argued and considered, the Board would then recess the Hearing on the Merits pending the Board's deliberation and rulings with respect to the two motions. All other matters, including previously set deadlines, would be suspended and subject to future notice, subsequent to the Board's decisions on the motions.

Accordingly, the Board hereby orders that Complainant Craig Pinkney's filing of a 2nd Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint (PPC) on October 14, 2017 is accepted as a second motion to amend the prohibited practice complaint affecting consolidated cases 17-CE-10-900 and 17-CU-10-356. Further, the Respondents' response is due by October 30, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. (HST).
