On February 23, 2018, HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO, (Complainant), through its counsel Peter Liholiho Trask, Esq., filed HGEA/AFSCME'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED ON JANUARY 30, 2018 (Motion) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) §§ 12-42-8(g)(3)(C) and 12-42-44.

No response from Respondents' counsel, Bosko Petricevic, Deputy Attorney General, to Complainant's motion was received by the Board prior to the five-day deadline pursuant to HAR § 12-42-8(g)(3)(C)(iii).

HAR § 12-42-44 provides that, "Any complaint may be withdrawn at any time prior to the issuance of a final decision and order thereon, upon motion and consent of the Board. Whenever the board approves withdrawal of such complaint, the case shall be closed." Based on a review of the record and consideration of the instant Motion, the

Board grants the withdrawal of the instant prohibited practice complaint. This case is dismissed with prejudice and closed.
