**ORDER GRANTING UNION'S MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINES
FOR SUBMISSION OF DECLARATION AND PROPOSED ORDER**

On January 11, 2018, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) held a status conference in the above-entitled cases. The purpose of the status conference was to determine the reason that the Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, LOCAL 646, AFSCME, AFL-CIO (Complainant or UPW) had not prepared and filed a proposed order granting its motion for allowance of costs and attorney's fees subject to a "more detailed breakdown" and incorporating consolidation of arguments and Board ruling in the above-referenced cases as directed by the Board in an oral ruling rendered on May 2, 2011 (Proposed Order). In response to the Board's inquiry as to the reason that the submissions had not been made as of January 11, 2018, the date of status conference, Mr. Takahashi, counsel for the Complainant, indicated that the parties were in the process of seeking resolution of the issue of attorney's fees with the Respondents JIM HOWE, Director, Emergency Services City & County of Honolulu and KIRK CALDWELL, Mayor, City & County of Honolulu (City Respondents). Mr. Takahashi requested an additional 45-days to reach a "mediated settlement"; and if the matter cannot be resolved within that time, specific deadlines for submissions could be set. Mr. Nomura, counsel for the City Respondents, had "...no problem with a [continuance] up to 30 to 45 days..." Accordingly, the Board granted the Complainant's request for a 45-day continuance.


On February 26, 2018, Complainant filed a Motion to Extend the Deadlines for Submission of Declaration and Proposed Order (Motion), requesting that the Board extend the time to either resolve the dispute or submit a proposed order, a declaration, and other supporting documentation for its attorney's fees, to March 31, 2018.

The Respondents *have not filed any objection or memorandum in opposition* to the Complainant's motion within the five-day deadline set forth in Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(3)(C)(iii).

Therefore, the Board grants the Complainant's Motion for an extension of the time for submission of the Proposed Order, declaration and other supporting documents until the close of business on March 31, 2018.
