ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

On March 13, 2018, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (Complainant) filed with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) a prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) against the DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION, State of Hawaii (Respondent).

On May 23, 2018, Complainant filed, Complainant's Withdrawal of Prohibited Practice Complaint, Filed on March 13, 2018 (Withdrawal).

Complainant states in the Withdrawal, "*The parties request that the above referenced case be closed and all scheduled hearings in this case be removed from the Hawaii Labor Relations Board's calendar and docket. Respondent's attorney Jeffrey Keating has been notified about this withdrawal and its contents and has indicated he does not oppose it.*"

On May 25, 2018, the Board issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss Complaint (Notice of Intent) stating in part that, "the Board hereby notifies the parties that the Complaint will be dismissed unless a written objection is received from Respondent within five days of the issuance of this Notice of Intent to Dismiss Complaint, setting forth good cause for why the case should not be dismissed."

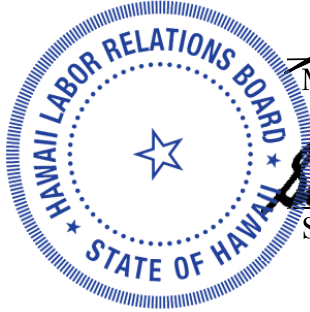
The five days has elapsed and the Board has received no written objection from Respondent. In accordance with the Notice of Intent, the Board is dismissing the Complaint.

**ORDER**

For the reasons given above, the Board hereby orders that the Complaint be dismissed with prejudice. This case is closed.
