**ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S WITHDRAWAL
OF PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT AND CLOSING THE CASE**

On July 20, 2018, Complainant ALLEN D. KA'AUWAI (Complainant), self-represented litigant (SRL), filed a prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) against Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (Respondent), alleging violations of Hawaii Revised Statutes § 89-13[(b)](4) for refusing permission for Complainant to file a grievance with the union based on his temporary union employee status regarding the principal of his school forcing Complainant to move to a workplace containing a student, who verbally assaulted him on March 1, 2018 and threatened physical assault against him on that day in writing, and allowing the principal to terminate Complainant's contract, effective July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2019, on June 29, 2018.

On August 10, 2018, the Board held a previously noticed Prehearing Conference in this matter. At that Prehearing Conference, Complainant appeared on his own behalf, and Respondent was represented by counsel. At that conference, Complainant orally moved to withdraw his Complaint (Motion to Withdraw). The Board orally granted the Motion and ordered the case closed.

In accordance with the oral ruling, the Board grants the Motion to Withdraw the Complaint and orders this case closed.
