**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS
UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY,
UHPA BOARD OF DIRECTORS, AND KRISTEEN HANSELMAN,
EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE FIRST AMENDED
ANSWER TO PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED OCTOBER 26, 2018**

On November 15, 2018, Respondents UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII
PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY ("UHPA"), UHPA BOARD OF DIRECTORS, and
KRISTEEN HANSELMAN, Executive Director (collectively "UHPA Respondents"), by
and through their counsel, filed a motion for leave to file their first amended answer to

the prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board. UHPA Respondents seek to amend their answer by citing two additional affirmative defenses to their Answer filed on November 7, 2018. UHPA Respondents contend that the affirmative defenses of *res judicata* and collateral estoppel are now relevant and necessary due to the Board's order dismissing the prohibited practice complaint in HLRB Case No(s). 18-CE-07-917 and 18-CU-07-368, issued on November 14, 2018.

After reviewing the record and the instant motion, and upon good cause shown, the Board, in its discretion, hereby grants UHPA Respondents motion to file an amended answer pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules § 12-42-43. Respondents shall forthwith file their First Amended Answer with the Board.
