ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME TO FILE PETITION FOR CERTIFICATION
OF REASONABLENESS OF SERVICE FEES

On November 10, 1980, this Board issued Order No. 365 directing the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly (hereafter UHPA) to file a petition for a new service fee review by December 19, 1980.

Subsequently, on December 16, 1980, the Board received a letter from Dr. J. N. Musto, Executive Director of UHPA, requesting an extension to January 15, 1981 to file its service fee petition. In his letter, Dr. Musto explained that more time is needed to complete UHPA's budget review and approval process and to obtain required information from its national affiliate.

Good cause appearing therefor, the Board grants the request for an extension and directs the UHPA to submit its service fee petition no later than 4:30 p.m., Thursday, January 15, 1981.
