ORDER REJECTING STIPULATION AND SETTING DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF BRIEFS

The University of Hawaii Professional Assembly filed prohibited practice charges in Case No. CE-07-21 and CE-07-22 alleging that the Board of Regents, University of Hawaii, and Geoffrey Ashton, Vice Chancellor, engaged in a prohibited practice by refusing to convene Step 2 grievance meetings on October 31, 1975 and November 10, 1975 to consider the alleged improper removal of positions from the Unit 7 bargaining unit.

A hearing on the aforesaid cases was held before the Hawaii Public Employment Relations Board on December 22, 1975. On February 24, 1976, the parties submitted to this Board for its approval a stipulation to dismiss the case with prejudice.

After due consideration, this Board hereby rejects the above-mentioned stipulation, and

ORDERS that the parties submit written briefs on the cases to this Board. Said briefs must be submitted no later than 4:30 p.m., Monday, March 15, 1976.
