ORDER DENYING MOTION
FOR PRETRIAL CONFERENCE

On January 29, 1981, the Respondent Herbert T. Matayoshi, Mayor of the County of Hawaii (hereafter County of Hawaii), by and through his attorney, filed a motion for a pretrial conference in the above-entitled case. In said motion, the County of Hawaii set forth an agenda of matters to be discussed at said conference including timetables for pleadings, for discovery requests, and for further pretrial conferences. On February 5, 1981, the Respondent Hannibal Tavares, Mayor of the County of Maui, joined in said motion of the County of Hawaii.

This prohibited practice case has been pending before the Board since June, 1980. During this period of time, prehearing conferences have been held on the original and amended complaints. The Board has permitted the parties several lengthy continuances for purposes of engaging in discovery, as well as for other reasons. The Board finds

that the parties have already had sufficient time to conduct discovery, to prepare for a hearing on the merits, and to have submitted additional pleadings that are necessary. Accordingly, a pretrial conference which would result in further delays in the proceedings is not justified. The motion for a pretrial conference is denied.
