## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION FOR INTERROGATORIES TO RESPONDENT

The application was supported by the affidavit of Complainant's counsel, Gregory M. Sato.

On February 25, 1981, Respondent filed objections to Complainant's application for interrogatories to Respondent.

A hearing was held on March 3, 1981 on the foregoing application, with both parties afforded an opportunity to present oral arguments on said application.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that based on the record and arguments of counsel, and for good cause shown, the foregoing application is granted with the limitations that 1) the interrogatories be directed to Honolulu Police Department Chief of Police Francis Keala and Deputy Chief Harold Falk only, and 2) that the interrogatories be divided into sets according to the employee-subject of the interrogatory.

Respondent shall file with the Board an answer to said interrogatories, with proof of service upon Complainant, within 30 days of receipt of the interrogatories as modified by this Order.
