ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR
LEAVE TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL

On February 20, 1981, Kevin C. Kennedy, counsel for Complainant Edgar H. W. Lum, filed with this Board a motion for leave to withdraw as counsel in the above-captioned case. The motion was supported by an affidavit wherein Mr. Kennedy avers that the attorney-client relationship between Mr. Lum and himself has completely and irrevocably deteriorated to the point that he can no longer adequately represent Mr. Lum and that it would be in the best interest of the Complainant to permit his withdrawal.

A hearing on this motion was held on March 2, 1981 with all parties present. There being no objections from the parties and for good cause shown, the motion for leave to withdraw as counsel is hereby granted.

Complainant is directed to notify the Board by April 1, 1981 as to his selection of a new counsel and whether a continuance of the hearing, which is set for April 14, 1981, will be required.
