The panel shall inquire into the causes and circumstances of the impasse and shall have such powers as are necessary to carry out the purposes of fact-finding pursuant to Board Rule 12-42-68 and 99-11(b)(2), HRS, and shall

transmit its fact-finding report and recommendations to the Board in the manner prescribed in Board Rule §12-42-69.

The fact-finding panel shall call a meeting as soon as practicable and shall conduct such other activities which, in its judgment, may be necessary to accomplish its purposes.
