CERTIFICATION OF EXCLUSIVE
BARGAINING REPRESENTATIVE

A representation proceeding having been conducted pursuant to the Stipulation for Conduct of Election and the Direction of Election by the Hawaii Public Employment Relations Board, hereinafter Board, in accordance with Chapter 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes, hereinafter HRS, and its Rules of Practice and Procedure, and it appearing that an exclusive bargaining representative has been selected; pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by Chapter 89, HRS:

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Hawaii State Teachers Association, NEA, shall continue in its designation and selection by the majority of teachers and other personnel of the Department of Education under the same salary schedule in the appropriate bargaining unit described below, as the

exclusive bargaining representative for the purpose of bargaining collectively on questions of wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment.

VOTING UNIT


INCLUDED: All teachers and other personnel of the Department of Education under the salary schedule pursuant to Section 297-33, HRS, employed during the payroll period ending April 30, 1981.

EXCLUDED: Part-time teachers (less than 20 hours per week); substitute teachers; adult education teachers except those on annual contract; summer school teachers; summer school supportive staff (counselors, librarians, etc.); special contract teachers (consultants, special projects, workshop teachers, etc.); ROTC instructors; driver training and education instructors; model cities teachers, PL 89-10 Title I (not on regular teachers' salary schedule); language arts lay readers; non-teacher athletic coaches; home/hospital instruction teachers (hourly or part-time less than 20 hours per week); non-teacher, non-athletic activities supervisors; part-time advisors, PL 89-10, Title I (drop-out program); student teachers; farm foreman.
