ORDER GIVING NOTICE OF INTENT TO DISMISS CASE UNLESS NOTIFIED OF WITHDRAWAL OR INTENT TO PROCEED

In Order No. 390, dated February 23, 1981, the Board granted Complainant's motion for indefinite continuance. The Board further provided in the order that any party wishing to have the matter reset for hearing upon the close of contract negotiations should so inform the Board in writing.

The Board to date has received no such notice from either party of an intent to have the matter reset for hearing or to otherwise proceed with the case.

Inasmuch as contract negotiations are terminated and a new collective bargaining agreement was executed between the parties on April 22, 1981, Complainant is directed to either file a motion for withdrawal or to notify the Board, in writing, no later than 4:30 p.m., September 23, 1981, of its intent and readiness to proceed with this case.

If Complainant fails to so notify the Board of its intent to proceed, the case will be dismissed.
