## ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On September 19, 1980, the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly (hereafter UHPA or Complainant) filed the subject prohibited practice complaint against the Board of Regents, University of Hawaii. On February 10, 1981, Complainant moved for an indefinite continuance of the proceedings as it was believed that the issues presented could be resolved during contract negotiations. The motion for continuance was granted in Order No. 390, dated February 23, 1981.

In Order No. 423, dated September 8, 1981, this Board directed Complainant to either file a motion for withdrawal or to notify it in writing, no later than 4:30 p.m., September 23, 1981, of its intent and readiness to proceed with this case inasmuch as contract negotiations had terminated.

Complainant filed a Motion to Withdraw Charge with the Board on September 17, 1981.

Pursuant to Board Rule §12-42-44, the Board grants said motion. Accordingly, this case is dismissed.
