ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION

On August 2, 1982, Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES' ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA], filed with this Board a Motion for Particularization of Complaint, together with a supporting affidavit.

Upon review of the aforesaid motion and affidavit and the charges set forth in the complaint, the Board concludes that particularization of the complaint as requested in Respondent's motion should be granted pursuant to Administrative Rules §12-42-45(b).


The Board directs the above-named Complainant to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of the requested particularization, with proof of service upon both Respondents, no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after the service of this order. The particularization should (1) specify the provisions of the collective bargaining agreement that Respondent HGEA is alleged to have violated; and (2) more clearly state the means, manner and acts

by which Complainant alleges Respondent HGEA violated its duty to adequately represent him. If Complainant fails to timely file and serve the particularization, the Board shall dismiss the complaint.

Respondent HGEA is directed to file with this Board the original and five copies of the answer, with proof of service upon the Complainant, no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of the Complainant's particularization. Failure of Respondent HGEA to timely file its answer shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the Complaint and Particularization and a waiver of a hearing.
