At the prehearing conference held on June 7, 1984, Petitioner's representative indicated that they would be unable to attend the hearing as presently scheduled.


YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the hearing in this matter originally scheduled for June 27, 1984, has been rescheduled for
