ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION

On September 25, 1984, Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA], filed with this Board a Motion for Particularization of the Prohibited Practice Complaint, together with a supporting affidavit.

Upon review of the aforesaid motion and affidavit and the charges set forth in the complaint, the Board concludes that particularization of the complaint as requested in Respondent's motion should be granted pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-45(b).

The Board directs the above-named Complainant to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of the requested particularization, with proof of service upon Respondent, no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of

this order. The Particularization should specify which grievances or complaints the Complainant alleges was handled in an arbitrary, discriminatory, and bad faith manner by Respondent HGEA. The Particularization should also have attached to it readable xeroxed copies of the documents which were attached to the Complaint.


If Complainant fails to timely file and serve the Particularization, the Board shall dismiss the subject Prohibited Practice Complaint.

Respondent is directed to file with this Board the original and five (5) copies of the Answer, with proof of service upon Complainant, no later than 4:30 p.m. of the fifth working day after service of Complainant's Particularization. The failure of Respondent to timely file its answer shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the Complaint and Particularization and a waiver of a hearing.
