ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANSWER TO PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On October 29, 1984, Respondent GEORGE R. ARIYOSHI, Governor of the State of Hawaii, by and through his attorneys, Michael A. Lilly, Charleen M. Aina and Russell T. Higa, filed with this Board a Motion for Extension of Time in Which to File Answer to Prohibited Practice Complaint. Respondent requested a ten-day extension from October 29, 1984 until and including November 8, 1984 to file its Answer.


In a supporting affidavit attached thereto, Charleen M. Aina stated that she has been in contact with the Administrative Services Officer at the Department of Social Services and Housing and with counsel for Petitioner in an attempt to resolve Petitioner's complaint amicably. She believes that a ten-day extension would facilitate an expeditious resolution of this matter.

Further, she represented that counsel for Petitioner has no objection to this extension.

For good cause shown, Respondent GEORGE R. ARIYOSHI's motion for a ten-day extension is hereby granted. As the Respondent's Answer to the prohibited practice complaint is due on November 1, 1984 and not October 29, 1984 as represented by counsel, the Answer to the prohibited practice complaint shall be filed by November 11, 1984.
