ORDER GRANTING, IN PART, RESPONDENTS'
MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION OF COMPLAINT

On March 13, 1985, Respondents FRANK F. FASI, Mayor, City and County of Honolulu, and MARIA BUNYE, Director, Office of Human Resources [hereinafter referred to as Respondents], by and through their attorney, filed with this Board a Motion for Particularization of Complaint, together with a supporting affidavit.

Respondents state they are unable to ascertain from the complaint which is narrative in form, specific facts regarding employees' names, dates, times and places in order to prepare a definitive response. They cite to Rule 10(b), Hawaii Rules of Civil Procedure, which mandates that all averments be made in separate numbered paragraphs.

Respondents to file their Answer in a timely manner shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the Complaint and Particularization and waiver of a hearing.
