ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ALLOW PETITION
TO INTERVENE AND ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR INTERVENTION

On April 12, 1985, the Hawaii Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA] filed a Motion to Allow Petition to Intervene. In an affidavit attached to the motion, HGEA's representative, Chester Kunitake, explained that HGEA failed to heed the deadline to file a Petition for Intervention set by the Hawaii Public Employment Relations Board [hereinafter referred to as HPERB] due to negotiations and ratification proceedings. For good cause shown and there being no resulting prejudice, the Board hereby grants HGEA an extension of time in which to file its Petition for Intervention.


Also, on April 12, 1985, HGEA filed a Petition for Intervention with the Board. After a review of the record and the Petition, the Board finds that HGEA has alleged a sufficient

interest pertinent to the issues presented to be granted intervenor status. Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(14), HGEA's petition for intervention is hereby granted.
