On April 25, 1985, Respondent TONY T. KUNIMURA, Mayor of County of Kauai, filed a Motion for Particularization of Complaint in the above-captioned case.

Upon review of the aforesaid motion and the charges set forth in the complaint, the Hawaii Public Employment Relations Board [hereinafter referred to as Board] concludes that particularization of the complaint as requested in Respondent's motion should not be granted. The Board concludes that no substantially useful purpose would be served by having Complainant, representing himself pro se, file a particularization. While recognizing the vagueness and indefiniteness of the complaint, the Board shall nevertheless require an answer at this juncture and hold Complainant to clarify at the prehearing conference and the hearing in this matter, the violations of the contract and

Chapter 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes, alleged and the relief requested.

Respondent KUNIMURA is directed to file with this Board the original and five copies of the answer, with proof of service upon the Complainant, no later than $4: 30 \mathrm{p} . \mathrm{m}$. of the fifth working day after service of this order. Failure of Respondent to timely file his answer shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the complaint and a waiver of a hearing.
