ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO WITHDRAW  
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT


On May 16, 1985, the Hawaii Public Employment Relations Board commenced the hearing in this case in Lihue, Kauai. After Board exhibits had been read into the record, Complainant, REGINALD P. GAGE, II, made an oral motion to withdraw his prohibited practice complaint. He stated that the matters complained of in this case was based, in part, upon another prohibited practice complaint which he had just been allowed to withdraw.

Counsel for TONY T. KUNIMURA, Warren C. R. Perry, objected to the motion. He argued that Complainant has made unfounded allegations against the Employer and the hearing should proceed so that the allegations could be refuted. He also stated that this case had been continued for over two months because of Complainant's request for more time to prepare his case.

Pursuant to Administrative Rules Section 12-42-44, the motion to withdraw the prohibited practice complaint is hereby granted. The subject prohibited practice complaint filed on February 1, 1985 is deemed to be withdrawn with prejudice and this case is closed.
