ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO SUBMIT OPPOSITION TO RESPONDENTS UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS AND STANLEY GONSALVES' MOTION FOR DEFERRAL TO ARBITRATION AWARD AND FOR DISMISSAL OF CHARGE

On May 30, 1985, the Hawaii Public Employment Relations Board [hereinafter referred to as HPERB or the BOARD] received from Complainant LOUIS VICTORINO [hereinafter referred to as VICTORINO] by and through his attorney, E. Courtney Kahr, and Respondents LOUIS VICTORINO and E. COURTNEY KAHR [hereinafter referred to as KAHR] a Request for Extension of Time to Submit Opposition to Respondents United Public Workers, and Stanley Gonsalves' Motion for Deferral to Arbitration Award and for Dismissal of Charge, accompanied by an Affidavit of Counsel KAHR. In the request and accompanying affidavit, VICTORINO and KAHR request the extension on the basis that the motion cites numerous cases which necessitate substantial legal research on the part of the Affiant. The Affiant stated that she is currently involved in numerous other cases which are making pressing demands on her time.

The BOARD finds VICTORINO and KAHR's request to be reasonable and based on valid rationale. Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(3)(C)(iii), the request is hereby granted. VICTORINO and KAHR are hereby directed to file their opposition to the motion by June 17, 1985.
