ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND TIME IN
WHICH TO FILE MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION
TO DISMISS OR IN THE ALTERNATIVE FOR DIRECTED VERDICT

On February 18, 1986, Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO, by and through its attorney, Charles K. Y. Khim, filed with this Board a Motion to Extend Time in Which to File Memorandum in Support of Motion to Dismiss or in the Alternative For Directed Verdict. Respondent requested an extension of time from March 5, 1986 to March 19, 1986 to file its memorandum in this case.
