On July 21, 1986, Intervenor GEORGE R. ARIYOSHI, by his attorney, Lawrence D. Kumabe, Deputy Attorney General, filed a motion that this Board defer or stay further proceedings in the above-captioned matter, pending the outcome of decision in Case Nos. RA-13-106 and RA-13-110.

The motion is based on the grounds that:

1. The above-captioned matter involves a petition to include certain secretarial positions in bargaining unit 3. These positions serve as secretaries to the positions of Tax Collector and Tax Assessor involved in pending Case Nos. RA-13-106 and RA-13-110.

2. The Board's decisions in Case Nos. RA-13-106 and RA-13-110 will in all likelihood dispose of the primary factual and legal issues involved in the above-captioned matter.

As a result, both Petitioner HAWAII GOVERNMENT 3. EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION and Employer GEORGE R. ARIYOSHI have agreed that it is in the best interest of economy and justice, that further proceedings in the above-captioned matter are deferred or stayed pending the outcome or decision by the Board in Case Nos. RA-13-106 and RA-13-110.

Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(3), the motion is hereby granted. Proceedings in the above-captioned matter shall be stayed pending issuance of a Board decision in Case Nos. RA-13-106 and RA-13-110.
