ORDER GRANTING, IN PART, RESPONDENT
HGEA'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

On August 8, 1986, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to as HGEA], by and through its attorney, Charles K. Y. Khim, filed a Motion for Continuance of Hearing with this Board. The motion requests a continuance of the hearing presently scheduled for August 14, 1986 to September 2, 1986.

In his supporting affidavit, Respondent HGEA's counsel states that Davis Yogi is unavailable to testify at the hearing as scheduled due to his participation in contract negotiations. In the alternative, Respondent HGEA proposes that the evidentiary hearing not be closed on August 14, 1986 but be allowed to continue until a further time to allow Mr. Yogi's testimony.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Respondent HGEA's motion for continuance, in part. The hearing scheduled for August 14, 1986 will proceed as scheduled. The hearing may be continued thereafter to permit the taking of Mr. Yogi's testimony.
