ORDER GRANTING, IN PART, RESPONDENT HGEA'S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING

On August 8, 1986, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES
ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO [hereinafter referred to
as HGEA], by and through its attorney, Charles K. Y. Khim, filed
a Motion for Continuance of Hearing with this Board. The motion
requests a continuance of the hearing presently scheduled for
August 14, 1986 to September 2, 1986.
