## ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

The hearing on Respondent EILEEN R. ANDERSON's Motion to Dismiss Motion for Lack of Jurisdiction and, in the Alternative, For Summary Judgment in Favor of the Respondent Frank F.

Fasi was held on March 5, 1987. After careful consideration of the arguments presented by counsel in their oral arguments and their briefs, the Board agrees with the arguments of the Respondent Employer that the proper avenue to vacate the arbitration award is through the circuit courts pursuant to Chapter 658, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Accordingly, this Board is without jurisdiction to entertain the merits of the Complainant LUM's Motion to Vacate Arbitration Decision and Award filed on January 27, 1987. The Respondent's Motion to Dismiss is granted. This case is closed.
